1-4 1s set, cross RH, 1st Lady facing out & down towards 2nd M
1st M facing 2nd L

5-8 1st Cpl set to 2nd Cpl and change places LH ready for

9-16 1s & 2s Ladies chain. 1s finish facing 1st corner

17-20 1s set to & turn 1st corner both H & face 2nd corner

21-24 1s set to and turn 2nd corner both H. Finish facing 1st corner
ready for

25-30 Left shoulder reels of three on sides 1s pass 1st corner L
shoulder

31-32 1s cross over to own side in 2nd place
